#### 7430 - **SAFETY STANDARDS**

The Board believes that everyone that comes to the district is entitled to function in an environment as free from hazards as can reasonably be provided. In this regard and in accordance with law, the Board will provide reasonable and adequate protection to the lives, safety, and health of its employees.

The Superintendent shall designate an employee to:

- A. be responsible for the maintenance of standards in the facilities to prevent accidents and to minimize their consequences;
- B. conduct periodic audits of health and safety conditions within the facilities of the District in accordance with the Federal OSHA standards adopted by the State;
- C. take appropriate action on any violations discovered during such audits; and
- D. report any violations thereof to the Superintendent who shall keep the Board informed of significant issues.

In the event an inspection is made by a representative of the State and a violation is indicated on the inspection report, the Superintendent shall report the violation(s) and corrective action(s) to the Board no later than at the meeting following the receipt of the State report.
