## 2271 - EARLY COLLEGE CREDIT PROGRAM

The Board recognizes the value to students and to the District of students participating in programs offered by University of Wisconsin system institutions the Universities of Wisconsin, tribally controlled colleges and private, and non-profit higher education institutions in Wisconsin.

The Board will allow any high school students who satisfy the eligibility requirements to participate in the Early College Credit Program (ECCP) and enroll in an approved course at an ECCP-approved institution of higher education while attending in the District. Students will be eligible to receive college and high school credit for completing course(s) at authorized institutions of higher education provided they complete the course(s) and receive a passing grade.

The is the School District's responsibility to pay for tuition, fees, books and other necessary materials for postsecondary credits per student for the maximum credits allowable by law.

The Superintendent shall establish administrative guidelines to ensure that the District's Early College Credit Program comports shall be operated in accordance with applicable State law and the administrative rules of the Department of Public Instruction. The Superintendent shall also ensure that allAll students enrolled in the District in the 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th grades areshall be provided with information regarding the Program by October 1st each year.
