Re: Required Notice of Academic Standards

Background

Under section 120.12(13) of the state statutes, school boards are required to notify the parents/guardians enrolled in the school district of the student academic standards that will be in effect for the school year. Boards must provide this notification annually, prior to the beginning of the school term. This notice may be provided electronically, including by posting the notice or a link to the specific academic standards on the school district's website. Also, the school board must annually include an item on the agenda of the first school board meeting of the school year (the first board meeting after July 1) that clearly identifies the student academic standards adopted by the board under section 118.30(1g)(a)1 of the state statutes that will be in effect for the school year.

Official Notice

For the 2022-23 school year, Ripon Area School District has adopted the Common Core State Standards for Math and English Language Arts, the Wisconsin Standards and Next Generation Science Standards for Science, the Wisconsin Standards for Social Studies, and Wisconsin Academic Standards for all other content areas. RASD has also adopted the Social Emotional Learning Competencies developed by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction for PK-adult.
